

# Provide First Aid

## COURSE OVERVIEW

Provide First Aid (HLTAID011) is by far the most popular first aid training course which incorporates Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (HLTAID009). In this course, you will learn the skills and knowledge to be able to provide first aid response and life support, manage casualty, the incident, and other first aiders until qualified emergency help arrives at the scene of the incident.

Participants assessed as being competent in all assessments will receive a Statement of Attainment in Provide First Aid HLTAID011 (including Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation HLTAID009).

It is recommended that Provide First Aid (HLTAID011) is **renewed every three years** and the Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (HLTAID009) component is **renewed every 12 months**.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To successfully complete this course, you must:

- Have access to a computer and internet service.
- Have literacy skills to read and interpret statutory signage, warning signs and instructions regarding the use of first aid and CPR materials, such as face shields, and Automated External Defibrillators.

- Have the ability to complete a Workplace Incident Report.
- Have basic numeracy skills to perform simple calculations about the rate of chest compressions and rescue breathing.
- Have a level of oral communication that enables you to make accurate verbal reports to emergency response services and workplace supervisors.
- Have the physical ability to meet the following evidence requirements:
  - Perform at least two minutes of uninterrupted single rescuer Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) (five cycles of both compressions and breaths) on an adult resuscitation manikin placed on the floor.
  - Perform at least two minutes of uninterrupted single rescuer Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) (five cycles of both compressions and breaths) on an infant resuscitation manikin placed on a firm surface.

## DELIVERY METHODOLOGY

This is a blended course with self-paced online learning and face-to-face training.

Before attending the face-to-face training, students will need to successfully complete their online learning.

### Online learning and assessment:

- Up to 3.5 hours to complete (approx. guide only).
- Assessment is a combination of short answers and questions with multiple-choice answers.

### Face-to-face practical assessment session:

- Five hours duration.
- Individual assessment conducted to demonstrate your new learnt skills and practise them with feedback provided from our qualified trainer.
