Certificate III in Individual Support – Ageing



This nationally accredited qualification will give you a firm base of anatomical knowledge, train you to provide individual assistance to clients in home, aged and disability settings, apply infection control measures, assist with the administration of medication to clients, and support people living with dementia.

CAREER PROSPECTS

The Certificate III in Individual Support will equip you with the skills required to work in aged, respite, personal, disability, direct and personal care roles.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You will need to have basic computer skills (e.g. the ability to access and use word processing applications, email and internet), a reliable internet connection and a working computer or laptop.

You will also be able to deal with the physical demands of manual tasks (e.g. bending, squatting, kneeling, and repetitive movements, carrying) and be able to be on your feet for extended periods of time as all individual support positions require high personal mobility.

COURSE FEES

COURSE STRUCTURE & ASSESSMENT

This dual stream certificate is made up of thirteen units of competency: seven core units and six elective units.

These units are assessed through a combination of short answer questions, case study scenarios, role play activities and vocational placement.

VOCATIONAL PLACEMENT

As part of the assessment of this qualification, you are required to complete at least 120 hours of vocational placement.

Our team will assist you in securing opportunities if you do not have industry connections.

In addition, prior to commencing placement, you must:

- Have a Working with Children Check (Blue Card).
- Have an NDIS Worker Screening Check (Yellow Card).
- Have an in-date (less than three months old) National Police Check Clearance Certificate.
- Have an up to date (less than one year old) First Aid qualification.
- Have a current flu vaccine.
- If your placement takes place in a residential aged care facility or a disability accommodation service, it is mandatory to have the COVID-19 vaccination prior to placement commencement.

Students are responsible for any costs associated with meeting these placement requirements and you will be provided with a guide for applying for them at enrolment.
