### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

You will need to have basic computer skills (e.g., the ability to access and use word processing applications, email and internet), a reliable internet connection and a working computer or laptop.

You will also be able to deal with the physical demands of manual tasks (e.g., bending, squatting, kneeling, and repetitive movements, carrying) and be able to be on your feet for extended periods of time as all community services positions require high personal mobility.

# **VOCATIONAL PLACEMENT**

As part of the assessment of this qualification, you are required to complete at least 120 hours of vocational placement.

Our team will assist you in securing opportunities if you do not have industry connections.



In addition, prior to commencing placement, you must:

- Have a Working with Children Check (Blue Card).
- Have an NDIS Worker Screening Check (Yellow Card).
- Have an in-date (less than three months old) National Police Check Clearance Certificate.
- Have an up to date (less than one year old) First Aid qualification.
- Have a current flu vaccine.
- If your placement takes place in a residential aged care facility or a disability accommodation service, it is mandatory to have the COVID-19 vaccination prior to placement commencement.
